Gnats	Ex. 8:16-19
Flies	Ex. 8:20-32
Death of livestock	Ex. 9:1-7
Boils	Ex. 8-12
Hail	Ex. 9:13-35



Locusts Ex. 10:1-20
Darkness Ex. 10:21-29
Death of firstborn
(Passover) Ex. 11:1-12:36
